PARTICIPANT INFORMATION

This is a serious boat-building event. We want to make it as fun as possible for the youth, and young at heart. Taking to heart these few rules will benefit all participants

- Instructors cannot watch over all youth at all times. There must be an accompanying responsible adult.
- Participants are expected to do the work on their boat themselves, with assistance and guidance from the instructors. Kits are pre-cut and tools provided, but instructors will not build the boat for you.
- Please commit to attending both Saturday and Sunday, and be ready to take your boat home with you when the show is over. The Port cannot store the boats.
- One friend or family member is welcome to participate with the registered boat builder and adult.
- Additional finish work such as painting or varnishing will need to be done at home after the show.
- Paddles and PFDs will be provided for Sunday's launch; however, they are Port property and will not go home with the boat builder. As new boat owners, you are responsible for providing your own equipment.
